## NEW MEMBER INFORMATION: PLEASE READ

### Standard Club Indemnity

1. Every member acknowledges that the property of members, guests and visitors, if left in the Club premises, is at the owner's risk.
2. Every member acknowledges that except in the case of death or personal injury caused by the Club's negligence the Club shall not be liable to any person for the death or personal injury or for the loss of or damage to any vessel, equipment or other property arising out of any activities which the member may undertake or in which the member may be involved as a member of the Club whether organised by the Club or otherwise and indemnifies the Club against all and any costs, claims, demands and liabilities in respect of the same.
3. Without prejudice to the generality of paragraph 2 of this standard indemnity every member:
  - (a) Warrants the suitability of his or her vessel for any race, cruise or activity in which he/she may participate and certifies that such vessel complies with the safety regulations locally in force.
  - (b) Understands that the safety of such vessel and her entire management shall be his or her sole responsibility, and that it is his or her responsibility to ensure the vessel is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by a crew sufficient in number and experience who are physically fit to face bad weather.
  - (c) Undertakes to arrange adequate insurance cover to include cover against third party liability whilst racing or cruising of not less than £2 million.
  - (d) Warrants that he or she is satisfied as to the soundness of the hull, spars, rigging, sails, propulsion (main and auxiliary) and all gear and understands that it is his or her responsibility to ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained, stored and in date and the crew know where it is kept and how it is to be used.
  - (e) Understands that neither the establishment of these conditions, their use by the race organisers nor any inspection of the vessel by and on behalf of the Club in any way limits his or her absolute responsibility.
4. Every member confirms that he or she considers that the terms of this standard indemnity are entirely fair and reasonable.
5. This indemnity takes precedence over any other club rule where there might be a conflict.

### Club Rules

Members agree to abide by all Club Rules as currently in force, copies of which may be viewed on the website [www.cyc.co.uk](http://www.cyc.co.uk). Dinghy Section members must in addition abide by Dinghy Park Rules and Duty obligations.

### Terms and conditions of Monthly Direct Debit scheme

1. The scheme is open to existing and new members.
2. Signing up to the scheme means that you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.
3. New members will be charged the entrance fee together with one month's subscription on application. Memberships applications received on or after the 20th day of the month will be deemed to start in the next month.
4. Monthly payments will be collected on or about the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month.
5. If a member resigns from the Club during the year, the following 2 months' payments will be collected together as a final severance collection. Should the member later wish to rejoin the Club an entrance fee will be charged.
6. If a member cancels his/her direct debit (without prior notification to the Club) this will be deemed as resignation from the Club and the member will be charged two months' payments as final severance. Should the member wish to rejoin at a later date any outstanding balance must be settled and an entrance fee will be charged.

### Harbour Dues

All vessels (including tenders) using Chichester Harbour must pay Harbour Dues and affix the plaque to their boat. Cost depends on size of vessel. Purchase at [www.conservancy.co.uk](http://www.conservancy.co.uk) or call 01243 512301.
